1. UP 09-013, CLEARWIRE WIRELESS ANTENNA USE PERMIT, 199 BRANDON ROAD

The applicant is requesting a use permit to install a wireless communication facility on the roof of an existing 29 foot tall building that would consist of an equipment cabinet, a 10 foot tall cupola structure – mounted on rooftop of existing building (approximate square footage, 7 feet by 8 feet), three 3-foot tall panel antennas, two microwave antennas, three RRU units (all mounted inside the proposed cupola structure) and one GPS unit to be mounted on the outside of the cupola. In addition, the Commission is requested to accept the Exemption pursuant to Section 15303 of the Guidelines for the Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, which consists of installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures. The project site is located in the *R-7 Single Family, 7,000 square foot lots* zoning district. Assessor's Parcel Number 149-010-082.

The applicant is requesting the Commission hold a study session to review and provide comments on a proposed new senior and teen center for the Pleasant Hill Recreation and Park District. The new and expanded senior and teen centers will replace existing facilities. The new senior center is proposed to be approximately 22,900 square feet and the new teen center is proposed to be approximately 7,400 square feet. No action will be taken on this item since it is a study session. The project site is located in the *R-7 Single Family, 7,000 square foot lots* zoning district. Assessor's Parcel Number 150-141-007.

In addition, the applicant will present conceptual plans for two additional separate projects for Commission feedback. The two projects include a new 23,000 square foot Pleasant Hill Recreation and Park District community center (replacing the existing facility) and to improve Pleasant Oaks Park, including grading, removal of trees,

resurfacing of existing playfields, paved parking, pathways and new irrigation. The project sites are located in the *PAO Professional & Administration Offices* and *R-10 Single Family, 10,000 square foot lots* zoning districts respectively. Assessor's Parcel Number 153-050-064 & 149-230-009 respectively.
