Submitting comments before the meeting:

The public may submit comments on any agenda item to the Education Commission by:

- 1) Emailing comments to gvassar@pleasanthillca.org or
- 2) Delivering written comments to the mailbox inside the lobby of City Hall during regular business hours.

All comments must be sent an hour before the start of the meeting.

Make a comment during the meeting:

Speakers are encouraged to call 10 minutes before the meeting due to a live-streaming lag-time, and will be placed on hold until the Public Comment period.

Comments are limited to three minutes per speaker. To participate in the teleconferenced meeting, you may call by phone to share your comments live at 925-671-5285.

The Education Commission will accept, but not discuss comments. When it is your turn to speak, the Deputy City Clerk will invite you. **You must mute your speakers if you are streaming live or there will be feedback during the meeting.**

We ask that when you call, you:

- 1) Try to be in a room or space without a lot of background noise.
- 2) Make sure you have a strong cell phone signal if calling in from a cell phone.
- 3) Do not call in while driving.
- 4) State your name and identify what agenda item you're commenting on.
